Stage 1

Making essential workplaces as safe as possible

Stage 2

Lower risk sectors may reopen with adaptations, gatherings of fewer than 10 may resume

- Essential businesses
- Manufacturing
- Warehouses
- Retail
- All other businesses

Later in Stage 2

- Offices
- Restaurants

Stage 3

Higher risk sectors may re-open with adaptations, limits on size of gatherings

- Essential businesses
- Manufacturing
- Retail
- Personal care and fitness
- In-person religious services
- K-12 schools
- Entertainment venues
- Concerts, conventions, very large gatherings

Stage 4

State-wide order lifted - return to expanded workforce in highest risk workplaces

Pre-Phase 1

Making essential workplaces - defined by CA order - as safe as possible

Phase 1

Some businesses may reopen partially or in a modified manner, gatherings of fewer than 10

- General businesses
- Fitness
- Parks, playgrounds & campgrounds
- Sector specific businesses
- K-12 schools
- All other businesses

Phase 2

With adaptations, many businesses may be most of the way open, gatherings of fewer than 50 may resume

- General businesses
- Sector specific businesses
- Fitness
- Parks, playgrounds & campgrounds
- Spa and massage
- K-12 schools
- All other businesses

Phase 3

With adaptations, most businesses can be open

- Large entertainment & sports venues
- All other businesses



General businesses =
retail stores, offices, manufacturing, personal care services,
hair/nail salons, barbers & body art facilities

Sector specific businesses =
restaurants, movie theaters, museums &
places of worship
